I am doing some church visiting in homes for our congregation here. We had twelve inches of snow two days ago so I rather got shut in and hence had time to catch up on some things.

when I came on furlough in 1955 I stayed three years extra until Mother died. Then I went back in 1959 and finished my time there. I retired the first of May after I landed in U.S.A. I was here and there until Late in Sept. when I settled down here.

I would be most interested in knowing about the early history of the Cathcarts. I have always thought I would go to S. Carolina sometime to see what relatives I might find! I know nothing earlier than that I have given here. So perhaps Mr. Robert Spann Cathcart will sometime let me know something of the Ireland Cathcarts. I visited Ballymoney, Ireland once and looked up the old place my greatgandfather Mathews left. My grandfather was about eleven when they came to U.S.A.

It is bedtime so I shall close.
